Indeed the Club has continued to grow and at the time of writing, 57 members had signed up during 2019, and attendances at meetings continues to grow and we now regularly attract over 40 members and visitors a month.





We do not indulge in competitions or formal judging, but rather we try to provide a platform for members to enjoy taking photographs, irrespective of their experience or the equipment they use. It is also gratifying that experienced members so willingly share their knowledge and experience to help us all develop our skills.

Throughout the year we have retained the meeting format that has been successful in the past and as the Club continues to grow I do not anticipate moving away from this tried and tested formula. Our principle activities have been;

PRESENTATIONS

Through a mixture of outside speakers and Club members we have enjoyed a broad range of presentations including "Photographing the Southern Right Whale", "Seals, Seascapes and Coastal Wildlife", "East Kent Churches", "Why RSPB Dungeness is so Unique", "Advanced Digital Editing", to name just some. We will endeavour to provide a similar eclectic mix in 2020. 



In the light of this sound financial position it is proposed that the annual membership fee remains at £15 for 2020, and the meeting charge at £3. As before, student membership will remain free.
